How to find the Latitude & Longitude of a location

1) Open an internet browser and go to <u>http://maps.google.com</u> & click on the google labs button



 In the Google Maps Labs window scroll down to where it says LatLng Tooltip & select Enable, then click the Save changes button at the bottom of the window

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3) Now there's a yellow box showing the Latitude & Longitude in decimal degrees of wherever your curser is pointing



4) You can move around the map by using the arrows on the top left side of the screen or by left clicking once with your mouse and dragging the map so that it is centered on your area of interest.



Now you can zoom in by either using the + button or by double clicking on the map.



Note: there's a scale on the bottom left side of the map for reference

How to show the Latitude & Longitude of one or more locations

1) click on the Google Labs button at the top of the screen and **Enable** the **LatLng Marker** Lab, then click **Save Changes**

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2) Navigate to your area of interest, position your curser so that it is pointing to the area you'd like to put a Lat/Long marker on, then **right click** & select the **Drop LatLng Marker** option
